

COOKIE POLICY

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that websites put on your computer, phone or any other device with information about your browsing on those websites. Cookies are necessary for making browsing easier and faster and they do not harm your computer.

Although this cookie policy uses the general term "cookies" since it is the main information storage method used by our website, the browser's "local storage" space is also used for the same purpose as the cookies. Therefore, all the information included in this section is equally applicable to this "local storage".

What are cookies used for?

Cookies are an essential part of how our website works. The main objective of our cookies is to improve your browsing experience. For example, the cookies help us to identify you (if you are registered on our website), remember your preferences while browsing (language, country, etc.) and, in future visits, manage your shopping basket and enable you to shop.

The information stored in the cookies also enable us to improve the website by using estimates for user numbers and patterns, adapting the website to users' individual interests, accelerating their searches, etc.

What are cookies not used for?

Our cookies do not store your sensitive personal information such as your address, credit card details and password. Likewise, we do not use our cookies for advertising purposes.

Who uses the information stored in the cookies?

The information stored in our cookies is used only and solely by us, except for those belonging to Google Analytics, which are used and managed by Google and by us for statistical purposes. We also have payment transaction analysis cookies which are generated when purchasing online and are analysed by an external company that provides sufficient guarantees regarding your payment transactions.

Can cookies be disabled?

Yes, cookies can be disabled. However, if you disable them, you may not be able to access certain parts of our website, your browsing experience may be less efficient and you may not be able to take advantage of some of our services.

If you wish to restrict, block or delete the cookies from our website, you can do this by changing the configuration in your browser. Although each browser is different, this is usually done through the "preferences" or "tools" menu. For more details about the cookie configuration on your browser, check its "Help" menu.

What cookies are specifically used on this website and for what purposes?

Identification and authentication cookies		
These cookies are used to identify users during the session so that the website authentication process does not have to be repeated and some website processes can be accelerated.

They provide general information about user access to the website, thus providing us with aggregate information of such access for statistical purposes.

The stored data refer to the user selection and the subsequent conversion.
Google Analytics (third-party cookie)	__utma, __utmb, __utmc, __utmz	They help us monitor the website using Google Analytics, which is provided by Google to obtain information about user access to our website. Some of the data stored for subsequent analysis are as follows: the number of times a user has visited our website, the dates of a user's first and last visit, the duration of those visits, the website from where a user has accessed our website, the search engine used or the link selected by a user to reach our website, the location of the user accessing our website, etc. The configuration of such cookies is predetermined by the service provided by Google.
